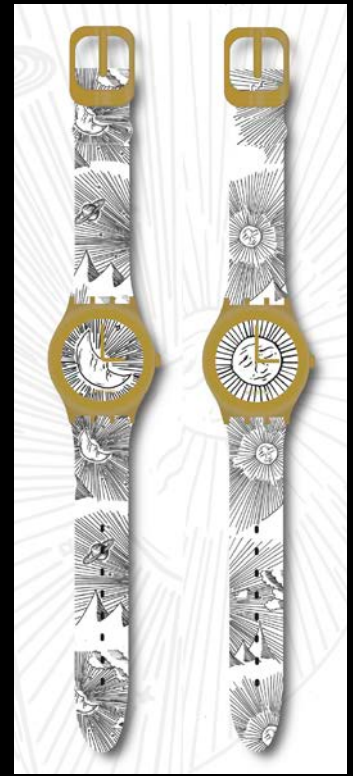
Graphic Design

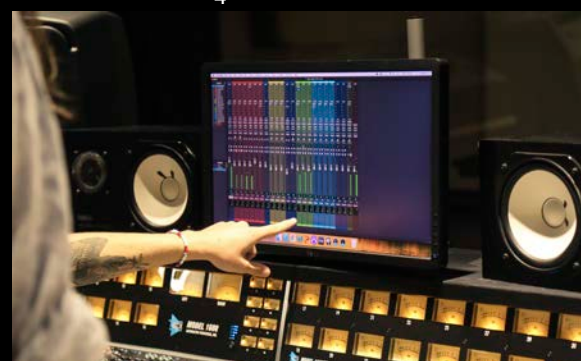

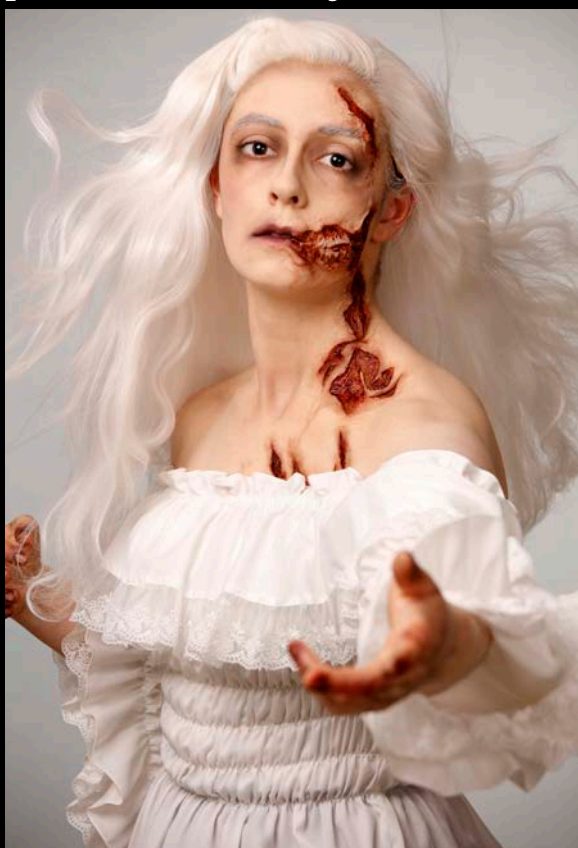
