Year 12 applicants

Current Australian Year 12 students apply online using Apply through UAC's website. Details on how to apply can be found on UAC's website or in the UAC 2024-25 Guide.

Non-Year 12 applicants

Australian and New Zealand citizens, and Australian permanent residents who are not Year 12 students, must also apply online using Apply through UAC's website.

On-time closing date

Early bird applications close on Monday 30 September 2024. Applicants for art and design courses are generally selected on the basis of folios, interviews, ATAR and academic results - refer to the course description on UAC's website for details of specific selection criteria and early closing dates.

Educational Access Schemes

Most institutions participating through UAC have Educational Access Schemes (EAS) for applicants who have experienced long-term educational disadvantage. Visit UAC's website for more information. If you are in Year 12, talk to your course adviser.

Schools Recommendation Scheme

The Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS) is one way institutions make early offers of undergraduate admission to Year 12 students. They do this by using criteria other than (or in addition to) the ATAR. Visit UAC's website for more information. If you are in Year 12, talk to your course adviser.

Equity Scholarships

Equity Scholarships are awarded to students from low socio-economic backgrounds, particularly those who receive Centrelink income support payments. Visit UAC's website for more information. If you are in Year 12, talk to your course adviser.

Key dates

Check UAC's website for courses with early closing dates. UAC charges and fees are not refundable, except as required by law.

Offers

VTAC Online Application

The VTAC Online Application is available from 9am on 29 July 2024 at www.vtac.edu.au. The service is available 24 hours a day and can be used by all applicants to make their initial application, make any changes to preferences and to check if they have been made an offer for a course.

Closing dates for applications

The closing date for Timely applications is 5pm 30 September 2024. There is a processing fee. Those who submit their application after 5pm 30 September will incur a late fee and may not be able to meet the selection requirements for some courses.

Art and Design courses

Applicants for art and design courses are selected on the basis of folios, interviews, academic results and other criteria. Applicants are informed of the result of their application by course authorities using four types of letters: Type A (i) states that the applicant has been successful in meeting preselection requirements, conditional upon meeting minimum tertiary entrance requirements, while Type A (ii) is conditional upon achieving a minimum ATAR (Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank); Type B is a holding letter advising applicants that they may receive a second round offer in light of offers made and accepted in the first round; Type C states that the applicant will not receive an offer.

Special Entry Access Schemes (SEAS)

Information on special consideration, eligibility and the different types of schemes can be found in the Access Schemes & Scholarships section of the VTAC website and will be updated for 2025 applications from July. Applications for special consideration via SEAS and for VTAC Scholarships will close 5pm 11 October.

EAS (Educational Access Scheme)

The Educational Access Scheme (EAS) can help you if you have experienced circumstances that negatively affected your most recent studies.

If you are assessed as eligible, you may receive adjustments to your ATAR or QTAC selection Rank. There are 5 EAS categories including Financial Hardship, Home Environment & Responsibilities, English Language Difficulty, Personal Illness or Disability, and Educational Disruption.

Application to study undergraduate or postgraduate art and design courses is usually made through the state and territory university admissions centres. Application procedures differ in each state and territory, so be sure to obtain a copy of the guide published by each admissions centre. A guide will be supplied to you if you are currently completing Year 12, or you can obtain a copy of each state's guide from the admissions centre office or your local newsagent.

You should also note that sometimes there are special entry procedures for art and design courses, and for some institutions and courses, application is made directly to the institution concerned. So make sure that you check the entry in this publication, the university admissions guide, or with the institution directly to see what procedures you should follow. The admissions centres have provided us with a summary of their procedures to help you out. If you have any problems or questions, check with your careers adviser, or contact the admissions centres directly on the numbers provided, or via their website. Note: These details were provided by the admissions centres and were correct at the time of publication.

Only Australian and New Zealand citizens and those who have had Australian permanent residency approved/granted are eligible to apply through TISC.

Applicants currently completing an Australian Year 12 secondary qualification should apply through TISC for courses at all WA universities, except for ECU's WA Academy of Performing Arts (WAAPA). Applicants who are not current secondary school leavers may apply directly to the universities or through TISC.

Applications

Applications for Semester 1 2025 will open on 1 May 2024 via TISCOonline (www.tisc.edu.au). The application fee for this year is \$92.00.

Potential applicants can access course and university information, information about applying, choosing courses, prerequisites, offers, and much more, by going to the TISC website. From here, applicants can also change and check university preferences, and find out if an offer of a university place has been made. Some applicants may be eligible for early offers – check the TISC website for details. There are two main rounds of offers in December 2024 and January 2025 and places are generally available in most courses for both of these rounds.

Art and Design courses

Selection for art and design courses is based on academic results, interview/audition, folio, and/or other criteria. Applicants should go to the TISC website for specific course selection criteria and requirements. It is important to choose the correct course code, as some universities use separate course codes for Portfolio or Experience Based Entry.

Educational Access Scheme

The EAS assists applicants whose senior secondary studies (or equivalent) have been disrupted or affected by various circumstances and may not meet the standard requirements for university entry.
